Career Connections Camp

Students will participate in a 2 week career exploration camp (July 8, 2018 – July 20, 2018) in which they tour a variety of vocational sites. Students will gain knowledge in vocational fields to assist in post-secondary planning. Students will also participate in evening programming in the areas of rehabilitation technology, Orientation and Mobility and Adaptive Daily Living Skills.

Requirements for Career Connections Camp:

- Approval from student, parents and BSVI counselor for participation in camp. All parties involved with the students must provide a signature on the application indicating a commitment to the camp process and procedures.
- Transportation to and from camp on Sunday (4:00pm drop off time) and Friday(3:00pm pick up time) afternoons. No exceptions.
- Requested documentation prior to arriving at camp. (IEP, O&M report, medical needs, emergency medical forms, etc.)
- Signatures on the participant disciplinary procedures form.
- Khaki pants and polo shirts for vocational tours. (NOT OPTIONAL)
- \$20.00 minimum for dining out experience



Transition to Life Camp

Students will participate in a 4 week camp from July 8, 2018 to August 3, 2018. Students will spend one week learning the curriculum of Skills to Pay the Bills and evenings filled with Rehabilitation Technology, Orientation and Mobility and Adaptive Living Skills. Weeks 2-4 students will be working at a vocational site related to his/her post-secondary goals. Students will be accompanied by a 1:1 job coach. Students will continue to receive evening programming weeks 2-4. Students will participate in a graduation ceremony on August 3, 2018.

Requirements for Transition to Life Camp:

- Approval from student, parents and BSVI counselor for participation in camp. All parties involved with the students must provide a signature on the application indicating a commitment to the camp process and procedures.
- Transportation to and from camp on Sunday (4:00pm drop off time) and Friday(3:00pm pick up time) afternoons. No exceptions.
- Requested documentation prior to arriving at camp. (IEP, O&M report, medical needs, emergency medical forms, etc.)
- Signatures on the participant disciplinary procedures form.
- Khaki pants and polo shirts or employer specific clothing for vocational tours.
- \$40.00 minimum for dining out experience (Due on July 8, 2018)
- Students will need a copy of birth certificate, social security card and completed tax forms to earn a paycheck prior to attending camp.
- Students will need to complete Mainstream application with the assistance with local Orientation and Mobility Specialist and intake process prior to arriving to camp on July 8, 2018.
- If required by vocational site, students will need to complete background checks and fingerprints prior to arriving on July 8, 2018.
